

After the four weeks of rehearsal, actors will present a ten-show run of public performances on the Nancy Power stage in the newly built Roxy Theatre on 124th Street during the Edmonton International Fringe Festival.

7 Mar 2024: Mister the dog marionette is finished and ready to come to Puppetland for stringing! All that remains to be done is finishing the coat and shading on the duplicate. Did I mention there are two of him? A marionette and a prop version. But from my design by the incredible @angelatalbot12.



10 Mar 2024: Some little wooden marionette feet, carved and sanded, some shellacked and buffed, awaiting their perfect shoes, already patterned by the wonderful @makicam... I wish you could smell the shellac on these wee trotters, it's heaven to me.



21 Mar 2024: The last hours of world puppetry day 2024 and the last day of the Wonderful Joe studio build. These are the magnificent people pushing through to the end with me, tired by fed by the traditional @johnalcornmusic family dinner (which happens nightly during the final week of a build). I love them all, and am so grateful for their skill, precision and the beautiful energy they bring to the work and to my life.







In 2015, Edmonton's heart skipped a beat as the beloved Roxy Theatre succumbed to fire.

As construction began to rebuild this iconic landmark, logistics and planning were central to the completion of this project. With almost 100 concrete pours, we worked to reduce interuptions on the busy 124 street. From shoring and underpinning neighboring structures to the meticulous construction of a 200-person main theater, every detail was crafted with passion and purpose.

Today, as the curtains rise, we invite you to join us in celebrating not just a building, but a symbol of inspiration, and the enduring spirit of Edmonton's arts community. Together, let's celebrate the Roxy Theatre, where dreams take center stage.



RONNIE BURKETT - CREATOR AND PERFORMER

Ronnie Burkett has been captivated by puppetry since the age of seven, when he opened the World Book Encyclopedia to "Puppets". He began touring his puppet shows around Alberta at the age of fourteen and has been on the road ever since.

Recognized as one of Canada's foremost theatre artists, Ronnie Burkett has been credited with creating some of the world's most elaborate and provocative puppetry. Ronnie Burkett Theatre of Marionettes was formed in 1986 and has stimulated an unprecedented adult audience for puppet theatre, continuously playing to great critical and public acclaim on Canada's major stages, and as a guest company on numerous international tours abroad.

Ronnie has received numerous awards in the Canadian theatre as a playwright, actor and designer for his work with Theatre of Marionettes, including the 2009 Siminovitch Prize in Theatre, The Herbert Whittaker Drama Bench Award for Outstanding Contribution to Canadian Theatre, and international recognition including a Village Voice OBIE Award in New York for Off-Broadway Theatre, The GLAAD Award for Outstanding Theater, Broadway/Off-Broadway, and four Citations of Excellence in the Art of Puppetry from the American Center of the Union Internationale de la Marionnette. In 2019, he was appointed as an Officer of The Order of Canada. In June, Ronnie will receive the Lifetime Artistic Achievement Award from the Governor General's Performing Arts Awards.

Ronnie's highly acclaimed and wildly popular improvised marionette vaudeville cabaret *The Daisy Theatre* has played a decade of sold-out touring seasons including Los Angeles to New York, Vancouver, Toronto, Sydney and Auckland, and follows the international successes *Penny Plain, Billy Twinkle, 10 Days on Earth, Provenance* and the "Memory Dress Trilogy" of *Tinka's New Dress, Street of Blood* and Happy. *Little Dickens* (The Daisy Theatre version of *A Christmas Carol*), premiered in 2017. In June 2019, Ronnie Burkett Theatre of Marionettes



premiered a new audience-interactive production, *Forget Me Not*. In 2022, *The Loony Bin* premiered, Ronnie's first solo salon handpuppet show since he was a teenager. In 2023, The Daisy Theatre cast took on Shakespeare in *Little Willy* for a seven city tour. *Wonderful Joe* is the third Theatre of Marionettes world premiere at The Roxy.



CRYSTAL SALVERDA - STAGE MANAGER/TECHNICAL DIRECTOR

With over 30 years in the entertainment industry, Crystal has been blessed to work both across the country and internationally stage managing some wonderful productions. She has had the pleasure of working with Ronnie for the past 13 years. She has also worked with companies such as Blyth Festival, Kidoons Network, Calgary Stampede, Necessary Angel, Soulpepper Theatre, Canadian Stage, Harold Green Jewish Theatre, just to name a few. Other work experience includes Operations for Field of Dreams and Little League Classic (BaAM Productions), Concert Stage Manager (Marquis Entertainment).



JOHN ALCORN - MUSIC AND LYRICS, AND MUSIC PRODUCTION

John Alcorn is one of Canada's premiere jazz vocalists, delivering his distinctive renditions of jazz standards on the most prestigious bandstands and concert stages across Canada. His list of citations and acknowledgements in music and theatre include both Jazz Report (Male Vocalist of the Year) and Dora (Outstanding Music) awards. As composer, lyricist, musical director, arranger and producer, he has collaborated with numerous significant Canadian theatre artists, including Daniel MacIvor, Deanne Taylor, Sky Gilbert, Theresa Tova, and Tomson Highway, and nine collaborations with Theatre of Marionettes.



ASHLEY CARTER - HOUSE TECHNICIAN

Ashley (She/Her) has been a full time Theatre & Live Event Technician since 2019. She greatly enjoys all her work, engaging in events such as concerts, conventions, galas, festivals, and, of course, live theatre. From events as small as a mic on a stand to as big as spending a whole week putting together a single day exhibit, there is never a boring day in live events. She is honored to be a part of the incredible Theatre Network team at the new Roxy Theatre!

Ashley believes that art, in all of its forms, is and should be a place of community, of expression, and of acceptance. Anybody anywhere, no matter their age, language, orientation, experiences, or tastes, can find art that speaks to them, and that's the way it should be. As a member of the Métis Nation of Alberta, Ashley hopes to continue the work this industry has done to create spaces that are inclusive, welcoming, and safe to all members of all communities, by incorporating the Métis values of Unity and Harmony, as well as honoring Tatawaw, the Cree phrase meaning "Welcome, there is room"



KEVIN HUMPHREY - LIGHTING DESIGNER

It has been 20 years since Kevin worked at the Roxy and he is excited to be back. Previous lighting designs for Ronnie Burkett include *Billy Twinkle: Requiem for a Golden Boy* and *Penny Plain.* Other selected lighting designs include *Pride and Prejudice, Avenue Q, Romeo & Juliet* and *Trouble in Mind* (Citadel Theatre); *Jason Kenney's Hot Boy Summer* (Grindstone Theatre); *Sister Act* (Mayfield Dinner Theatre). He is a member of the Associated Designers of Canada ADC659 and IATSE Local 210. He is Chair of the Alberta Section of the Canadian Institute for Theatre Technology. www.lxdesign.ca
